**Recycling Wheelie Bin collection service**

The Council has been made aware of problems with the collection of your recycling wheelie bins, namely the materials were sorted the wrong way round in the bin. Please resolve this issue and re-present your waste correctly for the next collection.

When the wheelie bins were delivered you received a leaflet explaining the correct way to use them, what can and cannot be put in them, how they must be presented and other important information. I enclose another copy for your information. This letter is also to advise you that should these problems continue without reasonable cause, the Council will issue you with a formal notice under Section 46 (1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 which will require you to present your recycling and refuse in the manner required by the Council. Should these requirements not be met, any further occurrences may result in a Fixed Penalty Notice of £80.
